



Last week, Margaret wrote to candidates for the City of Canning elections to ask if they support free and safe parking for Carousel staff, shop assistants and small business owners and managers.



Margaret has worked as a shop assistant at Carousel since 1992 and lives in the Beeloo Ward. In 2018, Margaret didn't have to pay to park at work. **Now she has to pay at least \$3 per day to park at work - that's more than one week of her wages each year.** Scentre - the owners of Westfield - is making at least \$750,000 from staff parking at Carousel alone each year. Margaret will be deciding who she will vote for based on whether candidates support free and safe parking for Carousel staff.
